The Southside table runner is another Doug Leko design featured in Tabletaskic 2. We fell in love with the diagonal design. For this one-day class, students must prep and cut fabrics, to be ready to sew from 9-4. Six stars, four-patch, and simple squares are pieced using a mix of strategies, including speedy flying geese and partial sewn seams. Please choose two high contrast color ways and one background color for the best results.

Background, $\frac{1}{2}$ " yard	1, 4 1/2" x WOF strip	6, 4-1/2" square (A) 4, 2" squares (D)*
	1, 3 1/2" x WOF Strip	2, 6 1/2" x 31/2" (B) 7, 3 1/2" squares (C)
	3, 2" X WOF strips	60, 2" squares (D)
Assorted Prints A (Stars)	From each of the 10 Med/Dark 10" Squares Cut: 1, 3 1/2" squares (E) 4, 2 1/2" squares (F)	
Assorted Prints B (chain)	From each of the 10 Med/Dark 10" Squares Cut: 2, 31/2" squares (G) 4, 2" squares (H)	

Binding, 1/3" yard, Backing, $\frac{1}{2}$ " yard, Batting * Scrappy Look: Combine like pieces that are labeled the same and use them interchangeably.

Standard Sewing Class Supply List

Sewing machine (in good working order)

- 18 x 24 Cutting mat (or larger)
- Standard 6.5 x 24-inch ruler (or larger)
- Scissors/snips
- Self-closing/Ergonomic rotary cutter
- Iron
- Portable ironing board/mat
- Optional: Extension cord, Best press/sizing, Thimble, spare rotary blades

Thread and bobbins

- Flat flower pins and magnetic pin cushion
- Fabric marker/pen/chalk
- Labels/stickers for labeling pieces
- Seam ripper
- Measuring tape
- Machine and hand sewing needles
- Safety pins
