This hands-on two-day project class is perfect for someone looking to learn more about what their machine can do or to learn new serger tips and tricks! During this class you will make the Dynamic Dorian Clutch & the Tidal Wave Runner! These classes cover a variety of techniques! 10AM-5PM - \$199 if you need machine provided - \$150 if bring your own Triumph



There is certainly more than meets the eye in the Tidal Wave Runner serger class! This double pointed runner will have you serging the wave, the Wave Stitch, that is. Block piecing is accomplished by the Wave stitch as well as over lock stitching. Pin tuck textures and covered cording are also featured in this bright table topper. You will find the Single Fold Bias Binder a great tool as it helps to create an opening for turning the project right side out!



Come ride the waves of improvisational surface decoration with the serger! The Dynamic Dorian Clutch class will spin you easily into learning new ways to use the cover stitch, pin tucks, flat lock and more! You will strip piece the surface and then embellish to your heart's desire. Final steps take you to zipper insertion and gathering as you complete this vibrant accessory!

SUPPLIES – Fabric and decorative thread will be provided with this class.

Triumph, Ovation, Accolade or Evolution (Power Cord, Manual, etc.) – **Please note:** These projects can be done on the Accolade or Evolution but will be more difficult to maneuver in the small space from needle to inside wall of machine.

Registration

To attend a class, pre-registration and payment are required prior to taking the class. Registration may be completed online, by telephone with your credit card (252-257-7117), or by coming into the store. After registering for a class, you will receive a confirmation email along with a supply list for the class. You will also receive a 20% discount on class supplies that are purchased at Quilt Lizzy. Please have your supply list with you to receive the discount on supplies.

There may be additional fees for books, patterns, software, special supplies or kits required for the class. Materials that are copyrighted must be purchased individually and cannot be copied or shared during class. Additionally, when kits are supplied for a class, the exact fabric from the sample may no longer be available; however, fabric of the same quality and representative of the sample will be provided.

Some classes may require preparation prior to the first class such as pre-cutting, preparing quilt sandwiches, etc. These requirements will be indicated on the supply list. Contact Quilt Lizzy staff if you have any questions about class preparation or supplies.

As many people are sensitive to perfumes and scented lotions, we ask you to avoid wearing them to class. Also please turn off or mute cell phones.

Cancellation Policy

Class registration and fees are nonrefundable. If you cancel 7 days prior to class, you will receive store credit.

For events where we provide an event educator, you may use your enrollment fee as a credit towards a future class if you do not wish to keep your event kit. For larger events we request you notify us of your cancellation two weeks in advance or your class credit will be waived.

Weather Policy

At Quilt Lizzy safety is our priority so when weather conditions warrant, we will cancel classes. If the Warren County School district is closed due to weather conditions, we will also cancel classes. Classes will be rescheduled based on classroom and instructor availability.
