All skill levels can benefit from the exploration of the machine features and will learn to utilize many of the available accessories and specialty feet. Experience the simplicity of setting up the machine for various stitching options. You begin with many ways to use the 4-thread overlock settings and move through Flat Locking, Cover Stitching and the Wave Stitch, just to name a few! All the stitch samples created in class can be organized in the provided notebook. At Quilt Lizzy our mission is to create a fun, inspiring, and educational environment for all levels of quilters, sewers and crafters. If there is a special project, technique or class that you are looking for, please let us know.

Registration

To attend a class, pre-registration and payment are required prior to taking the class. Registration may be completed online, by telephone with your credit card (252-257-7117), or by coming into the store. After registering for a class, you will receive a confirmation email along with a supply list for the class. You will also receive a 20% discount on class supplies that are purchased at Quilt Lizzy. Please have your supply list with you to receive the discount on supplies.

There may be additional fees for books, patterns, software, special supplies or kits required for the class. Materials that are copyrighted must be purchased individually and cannot be copied or shared during class. Additionally, when kits are supplied for a class, the exact fabric from the sample may no longer be available; however, fabric of the same quality and representative of the sample will be provided.

Some classes may require preparation prior to the first class such as pre-cutting, preparing quilt sandwiches, etc. These requirements will be indicated on the supply list. Contact Quilt Lizzy staff if you have any questions about class preparation or supplies.

As many people are sensitive to perfumes and scented lotions, we ask you to avoid wearing them to class. Also please turn off or mute cell phones.

Cancellation Policy

Class registration and fees are nonrefundable. If you cancel 7 days prior to class, you will receive store credit.

For events where we provide an event educator, you may use your enrollment fee as a credit towards a future class if you do not wish to keep your event kit. For larger events we request your notify us of your cancellation two weeks in advance or your class credit will be waived.

Weather Policy

At Quilt Lizzy safety is our priority so when weather conditions warrant, we will cancel classes. If the Warren County School district is closed due to weather conditions, we will also cancel classes. Classes will be rescheduled based on classroom and instructor availability.
