- **Volunteers will pull up to the Painters Hall and will follow the Contact Free Sign-in steps, receive their Turf, Door hangers, campaign swag and a small prepackage snack.**
- **All Volunteers MUST have masks and adhere to social distancing protocols when attending Lit Drops and Other campaign events.**

**Safety Precautions:** To combat COVID-19 and participate in Labor 2021, all volunteers must follow safety precautions given by Local and federal agencies as well as Labor safety requirements. These precautions include:

- ALL CAMPAIGN VOLUNTEERS SHOULD BE VACCINATED (PREFERRED)
- ALL volunteers MUST wear mask
- Food & Supply Volunteers: must have gloves and mask to distribute supplies
- Lit Drop Volunteers Must have a minimum of a mask and be fully vaccinated
- All participants are asked to consider their health in all aspects of the campaign. If an individual doesn't "feel well" they must stay home and participate in the campaign in different way such as remote activity's phone banking, text-banking and social media organizing.
- Precautions Subject to change based on CDC recommendation and other COVID-19 information

## Lit Drop procedures:

**Goal:** To reach union members around our communities while adhering to social distancing and safety practices during the 2021 General Election.

**NOTE: ALL NEIGHBORHOOD TURFS WILL BE MINIVAN APP ACCESSIBLE ONLY.**

**Please Download the Minivan App before Lit Drop to Expedite Lit Drop!**

### Procedures:

#### All Volunteers will drive down to IUPAT hall

1. Volunteers will enter the IUPAT parking lot and procedure to the 2 tents: "Lit Supply tent and Supply pick up tent
2. Have volunteers' text their Full Name and Union to designated Check-in number (for contact less sign in)
3. After completing check-in and receiving turf, proceed to "Supply pickup"
  - a. Supplies: door hangers, turf code, minivan App info, Snacks (water/Gatorade/soda/ chips/granola/prepackaged), yard sign
4. Volunteers will exit parking lot.
5. Redirect volunteers to main road
6. After completing turf, Volunteers don't need to return to IUPAT Hall, Volunteers Must Sync Turf!

### Volunteer Roles:

Volunteer types needed for lit drops

1. Lit Drop Volunteers
  - a. Volunteers willing to pass outdoor hangers to union households.
  - b. Supply Volunteers
    - i. Lit Supplies
      1. Volunteers Will Distribute
        - a. Door-hangers
        - b. Turf codes
        - c. MiniVan Login (with quick guide)
  - c. Food Supplies Volunteer
    - i. Volunteers will Distribute prepackaged food
  - d. Traffic director, Direct people out of parking lot
