HONOR OUR NURSES BY PASSING THE PRO ACT



FOR MORE THAN A YEAR, our nurses and other front-line workers have heroically worked to keep us healthy and safe in the midst of an unprecedented pandemic. Many nurses have a voice on the job, but too many have been denied a fair process for forming a union. America's outdated labor laws are no longer an effective tool for making our jobs better.

The Protecting the Right to Organize (PRO) Act is transformative civil rights, economic stimulus and labor law reform legislation that would give our front-line workers more power and a greater voice. Here's what it would do:

- Protect workers' rights to form and join unions freely and fairly
- Keep health care workers safe on the job
- Hold corporations accountable for union-busting
- Repeal Jim Crow "right to work" laws that lower wages and reduce benefits
- Ensure workers can reach a first contract quickly after a union is recognized

Let's change the power dynamics in America and give front-line workers a real say in our future. The PRO Act would create pathways for workers to form unions, without fear, regardless of region and industry. Stronger unions mean higher wages, safer working conditions and dignity for all.

The House of Representatives passed the PRO Act on March 9 on a bipartisan vote. President Biden has called on the Senate to send the PRO Act to his desk. It's time for the Senate to answer his call and stand with front-line workers by passing the PRO Act at once.
