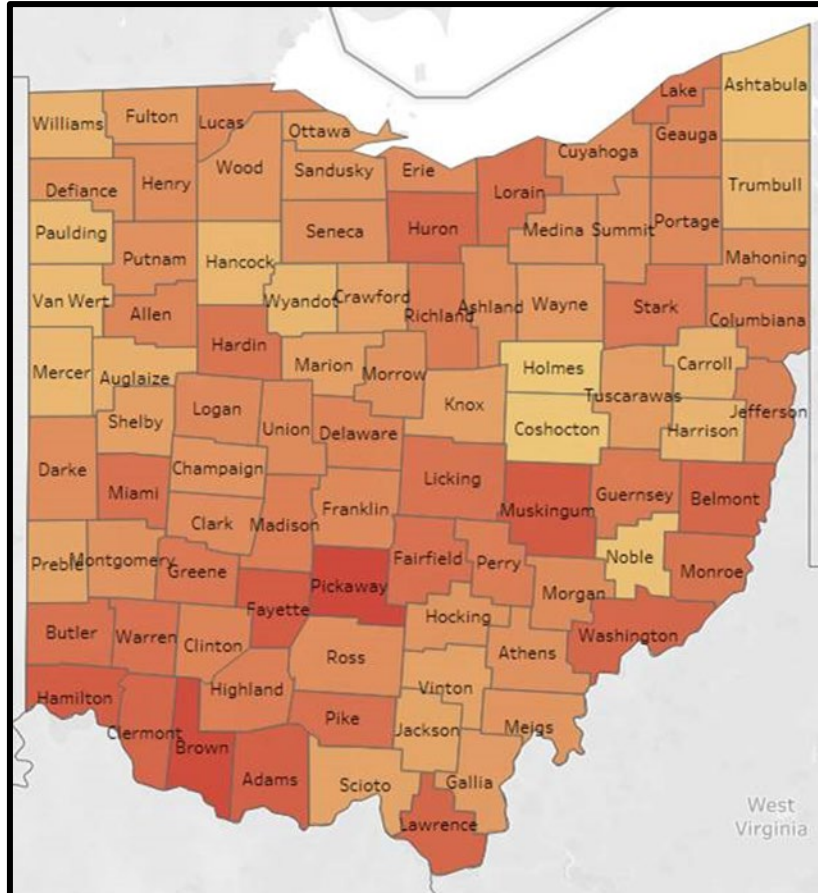
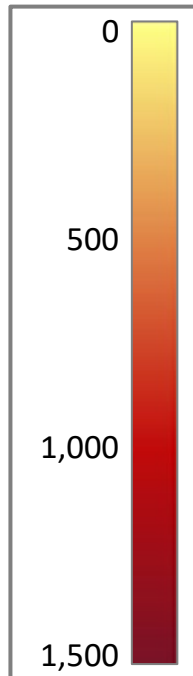

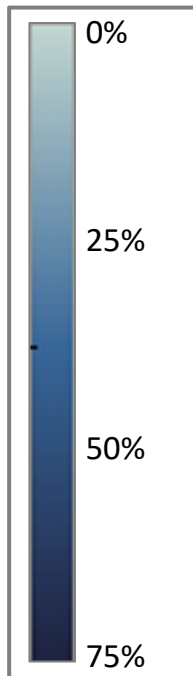
**Incidence—Cases per 100,000
