Welcome to Labor Day 2024! Thank you for being a part of our Labor Day Celebration at the Great American Ballpark to celebrate working people and the one day set aside for all who work or have labored to make this Nation strong.

All individuals who purchased a ticket(s) to the Labor Day, Monday, September 2, 4:10 Reds vs Astros game through the AFL-CIO Labor Day program receive exclusive early access to the ballpark starting at 12PM. This early access to the ballpark will be located in the Fan Zone. To enter, tickets will be scanned at **Gate J** just outside of the Hall of Fame (see graphic).

Once inside, join in the fun and camaraderie in the Fan Zone. Reds will offer \$1 Ice Cream, \$2 Hot Dogs, and \$3 12oz Beers (Bud, Bud Light, and Busch Light) from **12:10PM – 2:40PM**. Once gates open to the public, Reds CANNOT offer this special anymore, but you will be able to get \$5 Large Beers at the Garden Bar until the 1st pitch.

In The Fan Zone, many amenities will be open during the pre-event – Playground for Kids, Wiffle Ball Field (with a pitcher provided by the Reds), and full use of the stage. The carnival games will open at 2:40 when gates open (note, there is a small fee).

NOTE: Great American Ball Park food policy allows guests to bring their own food and unopened non-alcoholic drinks in sealed plastic bottles. Glass bottles, cans, or alcoholic beverages are restricted inside the ballpark. Soft-sided coolers with dimensions of 16" x 16" x 8" are permitted, so you are welcome to pack it in if you prefer not to buy it at the park.

There will be music provided on the Fan Zone Stage from Noon till 1:30 provided by **TBD**. Then a number of regional, state, and national Labor and elected leaders will give brief Labor Day messages from the Fan Zone Stage. There will be music after that featuring **TBD**.

So, get ready to play and celebrate US! The working people of this town in one of the many houses built by Labor! This is your day to shine! See you at Great American Ball Park as we celebrate Great Americans!
