

MRV Hub Work Crews Update

MRV Hub Work Crew Leads have completed a series of bi-weekly and monthly capacity building sessions with the Development Teams of the Forestry and Other Land Use (FOLU), Data Management Systems (DMS), and On-Road Mobile Source work crews. In addition to these sessions, members were also enrolled in the online IPCC Guidelines for National Inventories courses hosted through the Greenhouse Gas Management Institute (GHGMI). These sector-specific sessions develop skillsets, which enhance the work of individual work crew members and support the MRV Hub as a country-driven partnership, unlocking the capability of countries to cooperate on technical challenges underlying climate measurement and reporting.



The work crews are comprised of experts from MRV Hub member countries, other states across the region and the international scientific community. This includes Antigua and Barbuda, Belize, Barbados, Grenada, Guyana, Jamaica, Saint Lucia, St. Kitts and Nevis, St. Vincent and Trinidad and Tobago, Suriname, Canada, USA, and South Africa. The work crews

have now transitioned to the data collection and DMS design work phase. The sector-specific activity data collection will be used to make preliminary emissions estimates. Gaps identified in available data and documentation will guide the development of tools and guidance documents that strengthen MRV Hub Member Country MRV processes.
