

Congratulations to the students who took the PSAT/NMSQT® on October 30, 2019! They have completed a big step on their journey to college. Now is the time to maximize their effort. Parents, please encourage students to:

- log in to or create a College Board account online to view scores and test performance feedback. PSAT/NMSQT scores will be released online on **Thursday, December 12**.
- take advantage of free and personalized SAT® practice. Through the Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy®, students can access a preparation plan based on test results. Visit satpractice.org or khanacademy.org/sat, create an account, and link the College Board account.
- learn more about College Board National Recognition Programs, academic honors that can be included on college applications. They are not scholarships, but universities use them to identify academically exceptional students.
- begin their college search using BigFuture™. Students can explore colleges, majors, and careers based on their interests.
- continue to practice and improve. Juniors (class of 2021) are eligible to earn money for college by practicing for the SAT and improving their score through the College Board Opportunity Scholarships.
- register for the SAT. Take the next step toward college by registering at collegeboard.org.
