Little Vet School encourages K-2nd grade students to role play and explore the exciting world of veterinarians. Using interactive demonstrations, crafts and games, kids learn how to take care of a pet and use instruments that real veterinarians use.

Students learn:

- *how to measure and take assessments of their pet dog
- *the importance of proper nutrition and eating proper foods in keeping a dog healthy and growing properly
- *what to do when a dog gets hurt and how to care for stitches
- * the importance of ticks and how to check their dogs for ticks and how to administer tick medicine,
- * learn and discuss how antibodies recognize and kill germs that enter the body
- * to design their own Vet clinic and obtain their graduation diploma

Each student will take home their own stuffed animal dog that they will adopt along with tape measures, dog journal, dog bone cookie cutter, and so much more!
