Oliver and I were recently at a restaurant where a TV was on in the corner. He was clearly distracted by it.

"What's 'NFL' stand for?" he asked me.

"National Football League," I replied.

"Oh," he said, "so they're playing football news instead of bad news."

I paused for a moment. Do our children today believe that bad is the default for news?

"Well," I said after reflecting, "there are lots of kinds of news: sports news, national news, what's happening in our world. There's school news, and, actually, there's even good news. Can you think of some good news?"

Oliver thought for a minute and then asked, "Have I told you about the Macy's Thanksgiving Day parade?" He was referring to an effort at his school that involved creating "floats" and parading them through the hallways. "Tell me more," I urged him...

Friends, my conversation with Oliver was a reminder that we are bearers of the gospel—the good news of Jesus. In fact, the Advent and Christmas seasons emphasize that this good news has come into the world to counter the bad news that sometimes feels so pervasive today.

If we let the bad news win, we live in despair. If we believe in, look for, and proclaim the good news, we live in hope.

For the next month, we will dwell in good news, the good news that Jesus came into the world to change its trajectory. Let us not lose heart, but let us live in this hope—in this good news.

MUSIC CHANGES FOR 2025

The Church Council has approved Gwen Postle to become Director of the Adult, Children's, and Handbell Choirs at Holy Trinity effective January 1, 2025.

I will continue as Director of Music, accompanying the choir as well as playing the organ and piano for services and also scheduling and working with soloists. (While I have been directing choirs for sixty years, my first love has always been playing keyboard instruments, to which I will now devote maximum time.)

We are very fortunate to have Gwen assume this responsibility. Well known to us as a member with a warm personality and a kind and loving manner, she is a Seattle native and was educated at Washington State University with a Master's in Music from the University of York. She has taught brass and piano in group and private lessons, general music, and directed bands and handbell ensembles ranging from elementary through college age.

Currently, Gwen is high school music director at the highly-regarded Pioneer Springs Community School in Huntersville.

At Holy Trinity, Gwen Postle is also working with Luke Reinke to revitalize the Children's Choir and, in time, will reorganize the Handbell Choir. Since she has worked closely with me over the past dozen years, both of us are looking forward to expanded cooperative efforts. As is the congregation!
