# Subscribe to All Ops Wires (AOW)



All Ops Wires are available to all customers. However, subscription is voluntary and, therefore, **you must subscribe to receive notification.**

1. Right click under your name
2. Click on “Notifications”
3. Add a new subscription
4. Under Application, select “Documents”
5. Check the box for All Ops Wires and any other documentation you wish to receive

This is the best way to receive urgent and important communications regarding your engines.
