- I. Title of Abstract
- II. Author(s), Institution (including department)
- III. Contact information of presenting Student Author and corresponding Faculty Mentor/Senior Author, including address, phone number and email as well as graduate or undergraduate designation.
- IV. Abstract (up to 250 words, without counting I-III above)
 - For research/empirical abstracts use the following headings: Background, Objective(s), Methods, Results, Conclusion(s).
 - For lessons learned and practice-based abstracts use the following headings: Background, Description, Lessons Learned, Implications.

Delta Omega Eta Chapter Poster Contest Guidelines

Spring 2025 *In-Person* Poster Session

- The poster should be no larger than 5'x7' and no pushpins. Velcro will be provided.
- The poster topic should be on a public health related subject.
- The poster should be based on research already conducted by the student rather than a proposal for future research. The review committee will consider only student work that is completed or near completion.
- The poster should demonstrate appropriate and rigorous research design.
- The poster should demonstrate, if relevant, the use of appropriate data analyses to test the hypothesis.
- Judging components will include the following criteria:
 - Importance to public health and originality
 - Appropriateness of methods
 - Evidence of supporting data
 - Philosophy and theory
 - Quality and clarity of presentation
- The poster contest judging will be held on Friday, April 4, 2025.
- The poster must be hung no later than 3:00pm on April 4th.
- Contestants must be present from 3:30-5:30pm for judging in order to be considered for awards.
- The competition will be held at the New Orleans BioInnovation Center (1441 Canal St.
- The competition is open to all public health graduate, undergraduate and dual/joint degree students.
- Winners will be announced during the competition on April 4th.
