



It's time for the LSC annual Halloween Fun Show! We will have gymkhana and jumping classes in the morning, and dressage in the afternoon. Courtesy of Waimea Feed we have some great prizes!! This is always loads of fun and we look forward to seeing you on Sunday October 26 at Lil' Man Ranch on Lalamilo Farm Lots Road in Waimea. Grounds open at 8am, show starts at 9am, come join us! 🎃

Description of Classes

- 1.) **Leadline Costume Parade:** This class is pinned with participation ribbons. Riders and their handlers enter the arena thanking the gate attendant, walk a lap, line up, talk-story with the judge appropriately, receive a ribbon, pat their mount and exit the arena. For this show, riders sport their Halloween costumes.
- 2.) **Pumpkin Patch GRAB and GO 13 and Under** Fastest time wins, placed through 6th and everyone gets a pumpkin!
- 3.) **Pumpkin Patch grab and go! OPEN** Fastest time wins, placed through 6th and everyone gets a pumpkin!
- 4.) **Trick-Or-Treat Trail 13 and Under:** Riders proceed through the course, navigating either the pole or the traditional obstacle (such as a bridge, gate, log, etc), and help themselves to 1 treat at each obstacle. Riders can keep their treats.
- 5.) **Trick-Or-Treat Trail OPEN:** Riders proceed through the trail course, earning points for their performance at each obstacle. This class is competitive. Trail Course is open from 9-lunch, and pinned at lunch after scores have been tallied.
- 6.) **Eyeball-In-Spoon, Walk-Trot/Walk-Jog** All riders are given a spoon and an "eyeball" to balance upon it. The judge calls out commands which the riders follow. Winner is the rider with their eyeball in the spoon the longest.
- 7.) **Eyeball-In-Spoon, W/T/Canter:** All riders are given a spoon and an "eyeball" to balance upon it. The judge calls out commands which the riders follow. Winner is the rider with their eyeball in the spoon the longest.
- 8.) **Sit-a-Spook:** All riders ride bareback and are given a "spook" to tuck under their seat. The judge calls out commands, which could include lope/canter, and whoever keeps their "spook" the longest wins.

15 min break to set course

- 9.) **Poltergeist Poles:** This is open to all riders Western and English including leadline. Loping/Cantering is permitted. Course will be posted. Leadline riders will receive a participation ribbon. All others will be pinned.
- 10.) **Candy Corn Pleasure Crossrails:** This is open to all riders, both Western and English. Entrants ride a jump course of tiny crossrails, none of which will exceed 1'. Loping/Cantering is permitted. Course will be the same as that for Poltergeist Poles.
- 11.) **Cornstalk Crossrails Equitation:** Judged on rider position over a Crossrails course, with jumps not to exceed 18". English tack only. Course will be posted at the show.
- 12.) **Cornstalk Crossrails Hunter:** Judged on horse's way of going. Course posted at the show. English tack only. Same course as equitation.
- 13.) **Eeek Equitation Over Fences:** Judged on rider's position over fences. Jumps set at 2', 2'3" or 2'6" depending on your class. Course will be posted and will include an in-and-out.
- 14.) **Harvest Jumper:** Judged on horse's way of going over fences. Jumps set at 2', 2'3" or 2'6" depending on your class. Course will be posted and will include an in-and-out.

LUNCH BREAK, featuring costume awards. We will be pinning for best costumes during the lunch break. The costume judge will have been roving the grounds all morning.

- 15.) **Doomed Dressage Test of Choice:** You MUST email us your test choice(s) WDAA and USDF (intro-GP) 1 week prior to the show. Western Dressage should be in Western Tack. English Dressage should be in English Tack. Times will be provided the day before the show. Test caller available.

More Information:

All vehicles will enter Lil' Man Ranch and immediately turn right into the field designated for parking. There are 2 gates, making it easy to pull trailers forward when it is time to leave. It helps those with trailers if the cars can park alongside the fence that fronts the road. Please leave enough space for horses to tie safely, but also keep in mind that ALL the trailers need to fit in that field. So park close enough together that we can all get in there. Mahalo.

All riders must sign a waiver upon arrival at the show grounds. Minors must have a parent or guardian sign for them. Trainers cannot sign for riders. You can take care of that at the secretary booth when you collect your rider number. The secretary booth opens at 8am.

The treats in Trick-Or-Treat Trail are candy.

Western or English tack is welcome in classes 1 - 10.

Classes 12 - 14c are English tack only. Class 15, WDAA tests ridden Western, USDF ridden English.

You are welcome to bring your own picnic.
