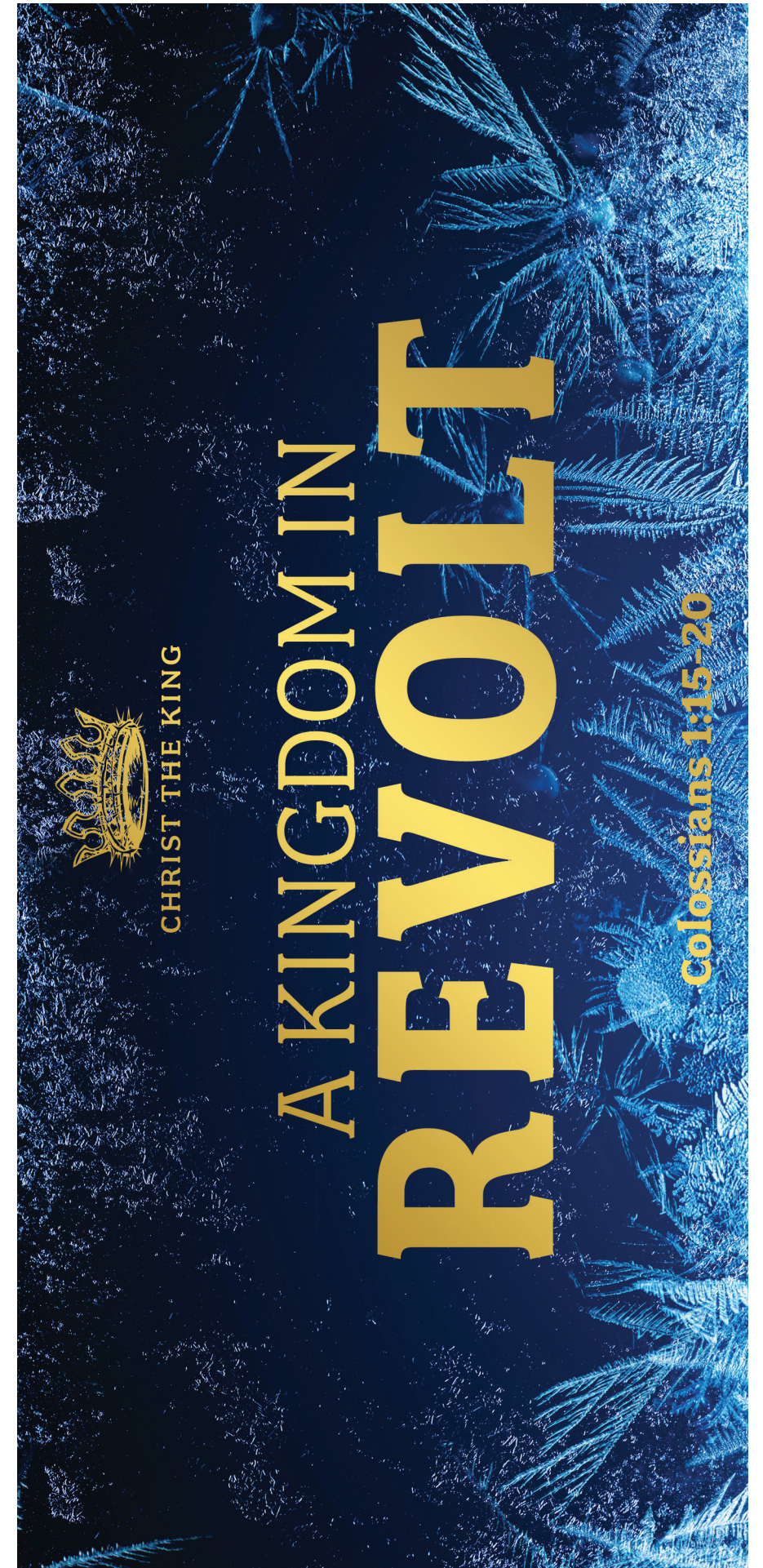
Jr High/High School students and Parents are invited to a time of student led devotion and a mix of large and small group discussions. Please join us as we breathe life into something old.
