Denver Health's School-Based Health Centers provide primary care, mental health, health education and insurance enrollment assistance services to Denver Public School students. Our medical and health professionals treat most health conditions that affect school-aged children during the school year keeping them at school and parents at ease.

Services

- Well Child Checks which meet the requirements of school, sports, camp and employment physical exams
- Immunizations
- Care for chronic conditions such as asthma and depression
- Care for acute injury and illness
- Prescriptions, medication and routine lab tests
- Reproductive health services including pregnancy testing and birth control evaluation, dispensing and management
- · Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections
- Individual, group and family mental health counseling
- Dental screenings, routine cleanings, sealants and dental x-rays
