Miss Creekside 2022 Pageant

Thank you for your interest in the Miss Creekside High School Pageant! The Miss Creekside Pageant is an opportunity for the outstanding young ladies of Creekside High School to showcase their academic achievements, talents, platforms, school involvement, and of course, grace and poise. Contestant applications are **due Monday, March 15th**; late applications will not be accepted. Application packets may be turned in to the front office and labeled *Miss Creekside (Attn: Fixel and Clukey)*. Be sure to sign up outside of room 135 or room 270 to be added to the Schoology Group (this is where you will submit your talent video); if you need to be added to the group, email or Schoology message both Ms. Fixel and Ms. Clukey. Pageant directors will make selections based on candidates having met all required criteria and audition talent submission.

Contestant Eligibility:

- ❖ Junior
- ❖ 3.0 unweighted GPA or 3.2 weighted GPA
- ❖ Active involvement in at least two school clubs and/or teams
- ❖ No disciplinary/attendance issues
- ❖ Completed applications to pageant directors no later than **Monday, March 15, 2021.**

Application Packet Checklist:

- Two Teacher Evaluations
- Parent and Applicant Agreement
- One-minute talent video (video must be submitted via Schoology)
 - Costumes are not necessary – rehearsal clothes can be worn
 - Only hand props are permitted – no set pieces
 - Talent audition piece does not have to be the same piece you use in the pageant, but the talent type must be the same category (e.g. a tap dancer may change the song but she must still tap dance)
 - Audition music, monologues, and presentations must be memorized
 - Contestant must perform alone

- ❖ Modeling (Formal Wear)

Community Service Platform: All contestants must declare a community service platform with which they are currently involved or have been involved. Your community service platform will need to be explained on your Portfolio Sheet (once selected).

Selection Process: Contestants invited to participate in Miss Creekside will be notified the day following the application deadline. The pageant entry fee of \$75.00 will be due on **Tuesday, March 23rd**. Each contestant is required to sell a minimum of \$300.00 in ads, which will be due closer to the event date. (Printed Ads will be in black and white.)

Miss Creekside 2022 Details

- All live rehearsals will be conducted in a socially distanced manner and all participants/directors/technicians will wear masks throughout rehearsals
 - Contestants will not be required to wear a mask when practicing/recording talent alone onstage
 - Contestants will also be able to remove masks for the opening number dance portions (social distancing will be maximized in choreography)
- Contestants will learn the basic opening choreography via video at home
- Mock interviews will be conducted virtually at home
- Interviews with the judges will be conducted virtually at Creekside
- Portions of the Pageant will be pre recorded
 - Pre Recorded Portions of the Pageant: Opening Number and Talents
 - Contestants will record their talents on the Creekside Stage
- Live Portion of the Pageant: Formalwear Walk, Onstage questions, Awards/Crowning
 - Contestants will arrive in formalwear attire on the day of the pageant
 - There will not be access to dressing rooms
- Each contestant will be allotted two spectators in the audience on the night of the pageant
 - Seating for spectators will be pre marked in a socially distanced arrangement
 - All spectators must wear face masks covering mouth and nose throughout the pageant and at all times inside of the Creekside Performing Arts Center
- The event will be filmed and streamed after the pageant concludes as a ticketed online event.
