How the Volunteer [Re]Builder Program Works

Join us in delivering real, hands-on impact through team-based volunteer opportunities. Whether you're swinging a hammer or organizing behind the scenes, we've got the tools, training, and support to set you up for success.

Key Volunteer Opportunities:

- **National Rebuilding Month:** April 24th & 25th, 2026 (Brookland Park & Highland Park, Richmond City)
- **Fall Fix-Up:** October 2026 (Hopewell, Petersburg, South Chesterfield)
- **Custom Partner Builds:** Available year-round with 60 days' notice

What You'll Need to Know:

- Teams typically include **8–20 volunteers** (shifts available)
- RT RVA welcomes everyone, **no repair skills required**, though we especially encourage teams with project coordination, maintenance, or general repair experience
- We provide training materials and technical assistance

Each Team Provides:

- A **Crew Leader** to:
 - Attend our Crew Leader Prep Meeting
 - Coordinate project site visits and homeowner engagement
 - Recruit volunteers via our sign-up portal
 - Procure materials using our Lowe's account and arrange tool rentals through the Richmond Community ToolBank
 - Manage the RT RVA-provided work scope, adjusting as needed to match your team's capacity
- A **Safety Coordinator**, who receives a short guide on site safety and wellness
- All volunteers must sign a waiver and wellness agreement prior to build day.
