

## **Southeast Nassau Guidance Center**

Southeast Nassau Guidance Center (SNG) is a non-profit community group located in Nassau County that offers behavioral health services that includes mental health, drug abuse and alcoholism treatment. Through their four programs (Seaford Mental Health clinic, Seaford Chemical Dependency Program, Wantagh Chemical Dependency Program and Levittown Chemical Dependency Program) the Center typically serves approximately 1,500 individuals annually, and sees 40,000 patient visits a year.

SNG experienced staff of psychiatric clinicians, psychologists, and certified alcoholism and substance abuse counselors, work towards achieving SNG's mission to serve the community by working with local schools, hospitals, community residences, other provider agencies, HMO's and Managed Care Networks. The Center regularly offers free meetings that on topics such as alcoholism, living with bereavement, effective parenting, depression and suicide, as well as other topics.
