— Subject Focus This Week —

Language Arts: This week, students will be returning to Writing with Skill. They will learn how to write an explanation by definition over a historical event, object, or location.

Math: This week, we will continue our unit on geometry, specifically introducing volume and other aspects of three-dimensional figures.

History: Students will study the role of the United States as an empire during the Progressive Era, as well as the impact and changes taking place domestically during the early 20th century.

Science: We will be wrapping up our unit on reptiles early this week. Scholars will be completing "Day 4" of their year-long biome projects as well as starting our unit on Aves. Scholars will be doing an observational lab exercise on feathers.
