Subject Focus This Week:

Language Arts: This week we will be working on our proofreading and editing skills! We will also be looking at two Robert Frost poems, and discussing the similarities and the differences between "Armful" and "The Road Not Taken"

Math: We have now begun our last chapter of the quarter - Chapter 8. We will be looking more into how to solve more complex variable equations using our four operations, but also begin to involve fractions and decimals as well.
