Ways to help

As an individual, Sunday school class or other small group, you can...

- **Sponsor a bed and mattress set.** \$300 secures a comfortable place for one student to lay their weary head each day. Nine bed and mattress sets are needed.
- **Sponsor a chest of drawers, bedside table or bedroom chair.** \$150 provides other basic furnishings.
- **Donate gently used furniture or lighting.** Sofa (1), Chests of drawers (1), bedside tables with drawers(4), bedroom chairs (4) may be donated. Other items needed include lamps (4), living room chairs (2), small kitchen table and chair sets (1), lamps (3), and stackable washer and dryer set (1).
- **Donate funds to cover basic household items.** Any amount helps purchase shower curtains, trash cans, kitchen supplies and cleaning necessities.
