FINAL STUDY:

The Gospel of John

Join the conversation as we open the scriptures and dig deeper into the Gospels. These focused studies allow time to savor and enjoy the stories of Jesus and his disciples more fully. Each study uses a guide for reading a few chapters of the Gospel each week with a devotional focus and also offers a format for reading the entire gospel.

The next and final study in this series for 2025 will be the Gospel of John, which focuses more on theological discourse, prayers, and conversations of Jesus, presenting a unique and profound portrait of Jesus as the eternal Word made flesh. This 8-week study begins in late September and concludes before Thanksgiving. Study books are available for \$10 each; email martha@stmarkstn.org for more information.
