

The sixth Endeavor module—the **Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC)** module—will officially launch **on Monday, July 14, at 10:00 a.m. CT**. Moving forward, faculty will use the Endeavor platform to manage their new IACUC protocol submissions.

The Endeavor system will provide Investigators with transparency into workflow routing, approvals, and provide in-system communications with reviewers. In-system protocols will also integrate with the soon to be implemented animal operations module for animal ordering, housing and census, among other things. We encourage users to use the new system for their protocols as soon as possible and are ready to assist as needed.

To support this transition, the **Animal Care and Use Program** and the **Electronic Research Administration (ERA)** team will offer training sessions and provide helpful resources for a smooth and successful experience. **Stay tuned for more information on upcoming training opportunities and support materials**

## **Transition Timeline**

**July 14 – August 14** Transition Period: Paper protocols currently in the pipeline for the July 24 meeting will be processed, but new protocols should be input into Endeavor.

**August 15:** All new protocol submissions must be submitted through Endeavor moving forward

### **Modifications:**

- a. Modification to paper protocols will still be accepted on paper until the protocol expires.
- b. Modifications for any Endeavor protocol should be processed in Endeavor.
