RE: Virginia Freedom of Information Act Request **[2021-FOIA-0517]**

Dear Juliet Hiznay,

I am writing in response to your recent request for information under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) which my office received on October 14, 2021. In your request, you asked for "Internal records sufficient to reflect mental health and physical health monitoring procedures that apply to persons being transported to local detention facilities by the Arlington County Police Department. This request is limited to records from January 1, 2015 through the date of the FOIA response." You also asked for "Internal records relating to the death of any person while being held in any local detention facility used by Arlington County law enforcement, including the Northern Virginia Juvenile Detention Center. This request is intended to include all investigative records for closed investigations, factual findings and conclusions relating to investigations, medical certificates of death and any communication records relating to the need for emergency medical care, transportation records associated with acute hospitalization and any requests for medical attention by any person who has died while detained at any local detention facility used by the Arlington County Police Department, the Sheriff's Office, or Arlington courts. This request includes any drawings, diagrams, graphics, video, audio or CCTV recordings that demonstrate the facts and circumstances leading up to a death of persons in the custody of the Arlington County Police Department, the Sheriff's Office, or Arlington courts. This request is limited to records from January 1, 2015 through the date of the FOIA response."

A search resulted in 223 documents that would need to be reviewed to determine responsiveness. It is estimated that it will require approximately eight (8) hours of staff time to fulfill your request.

Virginia Code Section 2.2-3704 (F) allows reasonable charges to cover the actual costs incurred in accessing, duplicating, supplying, or searching for the records. Further, "The period within which the public body shall respond under this section shall be tolled for the amount of time that elapses between notice of

the cost estimate and the response of the requester. If the public body receives no response from the requester within 30 days of sending the cost estimate, the request shall be deemed to be withdrawn.” The estimated cost for responding to your request is **\$200.00**.
