Author Dr. Alex Kor will speak about his new book *A Blessing, Not a Burden: My Parents' Remarkable Holocaust Story and My Fight to Keep Their Legacy Alive*.

Dr. Alex Kor is the son of two Holocaust survivors who narrowly escaped death. His mother and her sister were in Auschwitz and were victims of Dr. Mengele who used twins for horrific medical experiments.

Alex grew up in Indiana — a state with Midwestern charm and an ignominious history of prejudice. In *A Blessing, Not a Burden*, Alex details his incredible journey, from his unique upbringing to his present-day mission of carrying on his parents' inspiring legacy.

From his mother's controversial stance on forgiving the Nazis to his father's unbridled optimism, Alex shares life lessons that have helped him overcome his own hardships along the way.
