Students who know where their water comes from and how watersheds are impacted by human activities can become more engaged community members and better environmental stewards.



Posters can be created using crayons, colored pencils, charcoal, paint, etc. Entries will be judged on overall conservation message, visual effectiveness, and originality. Entries must include the following on the back of the poster.

PUBLIC & PRIVATE SCHOOLS: Student’s name, school name, educator’s name, t-shirt size.

HOME SCHOOL: Student’s name, educator’s name, email and phone number, t-shirt size.

CONTEST ENTRY DEADLINE MARCH 24, 2023

AWARDS: The top five posters from each school will be selected and those students will be awarded t-shirts and will advance to the county level competition. Five county winners will be selected and receive monetary prizes as follows: 1st place \$50.00, 2nd place \$40.00, 3rd place \$35.00, 4th place \$30.00, 5th place \$25.00.
