ServSafe® Food Safety Training

ServSafe® Food Safety Training is being offered by OSU Extension, Pike County. Food safety training is encouraged and in some cases required by your local health department and Ohio Department of Health as per the Ohio Food Code.

A registration fee of \$150 is non-refundable for both the class and exam.

The 2 day course will be held from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm on day 1, then 8:30 am – 1:00 pm on day 2. Classes will be held at the OSU Extension office, 313 Mill Street, Piketon, OH. You must attend both days to take the exam. The test is administered on the second day. Lunch is on your own.

The exam will be proctored by OSU Extension staff who will submit the exam answer sheet to the National Restaurant Association to be graded.
