# **What is NEEDED to Submit Your Tax Return:**

- **Photo I.D. for Taxpayer and Spouse, if filing jointly.**
- **Social Security cards for taxpayer, spouse, and dependents.**
- **Income tax documents (W-2's, 1099's).**
- **Proof of health insurance (1095 A, B, or C)**
- **Copy of last year's tax returns- this is very important**
- **For child care expenses, the total amount paid to each provider, provider's name, address, and identification number (social security number or employer identification number).**
- **For student loan interest, amount of interest paid.**
- **For education expenses, type of expense and amount paid.**
- **For direct deposit of refunds, bank routing and account number, and bank information. Bring a voided check or deposit slip.**
- **For Real Estate Taxes and Mortgage Insurance, the amount paid in 2020.**
- **Bring copies of any Economic Impact Payment (Stimulus) letters from the IRS.**
- **Bring copies of any Letter 6419 (2021 Advance Child Tax Credit)**

**IRS e-file is the fastest most accurate way to file your taxes. It's a simple process. IRS e-file means fast refunds - in half the time compared to filing a paper return - and even faster and safer with Direct Deposit...refunds in only 7 - 14 days!**

**Direct Deposit - An electronic transaction that is available to both e-filers and those filing a traditional paper tax return is direct deposit. Choosing direct deposit is easy; return filers just enter their account number and routing number on the return form. Those who choose direct deposit will get their refunds a week quicker than those who receive a paper check. Also, a refund that is directly deposited in a savings or checking account cannot be stolen or lost in the mail!**
