- Construction Craft Laborers are the jack-of-all-trades who work on almost all jobsites.
- They perform an array of tasks varying from simple to extremely difficult and hazardous.
- Laborers responsibilities include environmental remediation, mixing, handling and placing concrete materials, preparing and maintaining construction sites to eliminate possible hazards, and setting up traffic diversions or warning signs to ensure the safety of vehicles and their owners.
