In 2016-2017, students in grades 3-5 wrote code to move ozobots through the settings of novels such as *Bridge to Terabithia* and the *Magic Tree House* series.

After reading popular fairy tales, K-2 students put their design and engineering skills to the test! They worked on building homes to protect three little pigs from an unfriendly visitor, created bridges to help three billy goats escape a troll and constructed ladders to help rescue Rapunzel from her tower.
