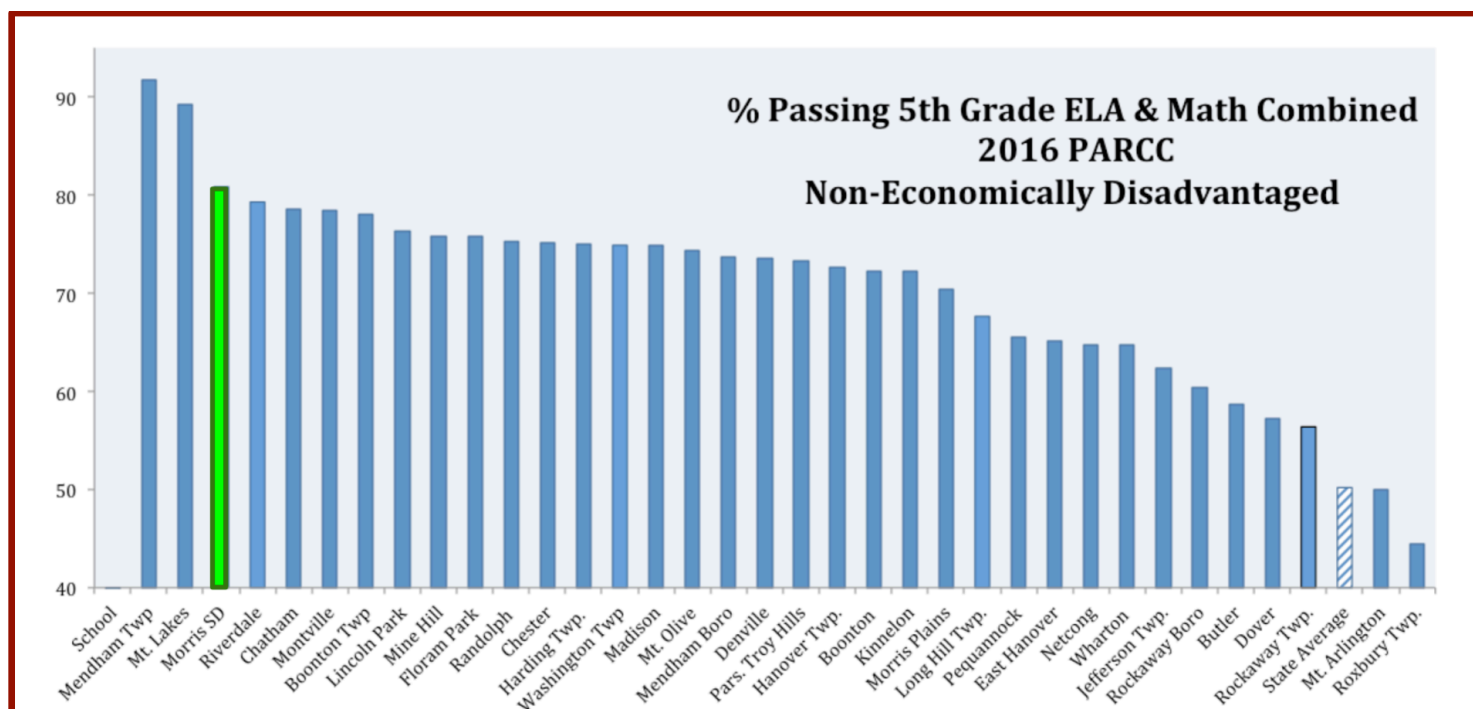


MSD Elementary Schools Academic Achievement
