New Hampshire Housing has teamed up with Joe Minicozzi, AICP and principal of Urban3, to analyze what types of development create the greatest tax return in 15 communities around the state. His analysis and research will be shared in a free webinar titled, "From the Outskirts to Downtown: Taxes, Land Use & Value in 15 New Hampshire Communities" which takes place on Thursday, Oct. 15 at 10 a.m.

Urban3 uses data to create 3D visualizations, and in this case used that data to reveals the potential for improving the fiscal health of 15 communities in the granite state. In Minicozzi's first presentation in the series, he will provide an overview of his analysis of property tax revenues in Berlin, Claremont, Concord, Dover, Exeter, Hanover, Hudson, Keene, Laconia, Lebanon, Nashua, Pelham, Peterborough, Portsmouth and Rochester.

Minicozzi will also be adapting his presentation for audiences on the Seacoast on Wednesday, Oct. 21 at 7 p.m. This session is hosted by the Workforce Housing Coalition of the Greater Seacoast, Portsmouth Smart Growth and Plan NH, and is presented by New Hampshire Housing. It will be recorded for those that cannot attend virtually.
