WCK has served millions of nourishing meals to people affected by disasters across the world—whether a hurricane, extreme flooding, wildfire, or humanitarian crisis. In 2022, when Ukrainian families were suddenly attacked, what started with a pot of hot soup on the border in Poland turned into one of the largest food relief operations in Ukraine in a matter of weeks. That humanitarian effort continues today.

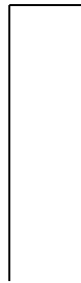
