Dear Saint Joseph High School Families,

Saint Joseph High School has applied for the eLearning waiver should we have inclement weather during the coming winter months. We may also use up to two eLearning days for professional development.

eLearning Days allow course work to continue on a day when school is cancelled due to inclement weather. eLearning Days can also allow course work to continue when classes are cancelled for faculty and staff professional development.

This allows students to continue their learning using technology rather than making up missed days at the end of the school year.

On a day when classes at Saint Joseph High School are cancelled due to inclement weather information published will indicate whether it is an eLearning Day or for professional development. Information will be found on Canvas for each class. This includes assignments, teacher contact information, and teacher hours. All assignments will be posted on Canvas by 9:00 a.m. on the day school is cancelled. Teachers will be available for students to contact them for four hours between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

While most Saint Joseph families have reliable Internet connections, we are sensitive to circumstances that prevent students from connecting. The school is open from 7:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. on normal school days if students need additional time to make up work. Students will have two days to turn in work when coming back from an eLearning Day. The Indiana Department of Education mandates that we count a student absent if assignments are not completed by the due date.
