

Scholarship Policy

1. Awards scholarships annually for: Accredited Higher Education Programs of Study.

Deferment Policies – Scholarships may be deferred by students who interrupt their education for mission/church service, military service, or medical reasons. A written notification must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee explaining the reason for deferment, when the student is leaving and when they expect to return. To reinstate the scholarship, the student must notify the Scholarship Committee two months prior to their return.

2. Deadlines – Scholarship applications must be submitted before April 1.

3. Funds are Specific – All scholarships are specific for the purpose they are awarded.

4. Disbursement is made directly to the respective Higher Education Program.

5. Other conditions – Other situations not covered in these policies will be considered on an individual basis by the Scholarship Committee and the Educational Enrichment Ministry Team

6. Any questions should be referred to the Scholarship Committee.

7. Awards are also given to students needing assistance for camps and conferences.

8. Scholarship applications must be returned to the church office at 406 North College Street Charlotte, NC 28202.

4. Acceptance (Provisional/Final) by Accredited Higher Education Programs of study
5. Three (3) references
6. Interview

Criteria for Selection

1. Applicant must meet criteria identified in respective Scholarships. Applicant/Parent/Guardian is an active, member of First United Presbyterian Church.
2. Applicant must be a full-time student for the year applying for scholarship.
3. Applicant must submit evidence of high academic achievement maintaining a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.5.

Award Period

Scholarships are awarded for only one academic school year and must be re-applied for by the student.
