



## GUEST POLICY

LPGA Amateur Golf Association San Diego Chapter welcomes and encourages guests (non-members and members from other LPGA Amateur Golf Association chapters) to participate in our events. It is important to note that men attending LPGA Amateur Golf Association Chapter events as guests will be treated as any other guest. Membership is open to men, should they wish to join, and all member benefits are available to male members except for non-eligibility to compete in official LPGA Amateur Golf Association competitive events. In accordance with LPGA Amateur Golf Association suggested guidelines, we have adopted the following guest policy.

Guests may attend up to two (2) LPGA Amateur Golf Association San Diego Chapter events (that are not member-only) per calendar year as guests. After they have participated in two (2) events, that person must become a member of the San Diego Chapter in order to participate in any event for the remainder of the calendar year.

This policy applies also to members of other LPGA Amateur Golf Association Chapters. However, for the first two (2) events in the calendar year, they may register as a member and pay the member rate. After two (2) events, they must become a dual chapter member.

Generally, persons registered as a guest will not be eligible to win skills challenges or game prizes at golf events. Exceptions to this may be made at the discretion of the Board or Golf Events Director.

The LPGA Amateur Golf Association San Diego Chapter has determined that there will be certain designated events during the calendar year which will be exempted from this policy. Those events will be the Holiday Party, the New Year's event, Superbowl Sunday, Roam from Home, and special Member/Guest events held periodically throughout the year. The Board may, from time to time, designate other events which will be exempted from the guest policy and will announce such exemption through normal communication channels.

All guests attending LPGA Amateur Golf Association San Diego Chapter events are required to sign the current LPGA Amateur Golf Association Chapter Event Waiver, Release, and Indemnification Agreement.

It will be the responsibility of the Golf Events Director to monitor guest attendance and to communicate that information for each event to the Membership Director. The Membership Director will communicate with guests who are approaching, or have reached, their maximum events as guests, and request they become SD Chapter members. Members are encouraged to make their guests aware of this policy.
