GUEST POLICY

LPGA Amateur Golf Association San Diego Chapter welcomes and encourages guests and members from other LPGA Amateur Golf Association chapters to participate in our events. It is important to note that men attending LPGA Amateur Golf Association Chapter events as guests will be treated as any other guest. Membership is open to men, should they wish to join, and all member benefits are available to male members with the exception of non-eligibility to compete in official LPGA Amateur Golf Association competitive events. In accordance with LPGA Amateur Golf Association suggested guidelines, we have adopted the following guest policy.

Guests may attend up to three (3) LPGA Amateur Golf Association San Diego Chapter events per calendar year as guests. After they have participated in three (3) events, that person must become a member of the San Diego Chapter in order to participate in events for the remainder of the calendar year.

This policy applies also to members of other LPGA Amateur Golf Association Chapters. However, for the first three (3) events in the calendar year, they may register as a member and pay the member rate. After three (3) events, they must become a dual chapter member.

Generally, persons registered as a guest will not be eligible to win skills challenges or game prizes at golf events. Exceptions to this made be made at the discretion of the Golf Events and Activity Director.

The LPGA Amateur Golf Association San Diego Chapter has determined that there will be certain, designated events during the calendar year which will be exempted from this policy. Those events will be: the Holiday Party, the New Year's event, Superbowl Sunday, and Roam from Home. The Board may, from time to time, designate other events which will be exempted from the guest policy and will announce such exemption through normal communication channels.

It will be the responsibility of the Golf Events and Activity Director to monitor guest attendance and to communicate with guests who are approaching, or have reached, their maximum events as guests. Members are encouraged to make their guests aware of this policy.
