The San Diego Players Cup 2022**



**LPGA Amateurs San Diego is proud to present the season-long San Diego Players Cup 2022, a stroke-play competition modeled after the Fed Ex Cup.**

**Event Format:**

- NEW THIS YEAR!** We will have 2 Divisions: Gross and Net.
  - Players may choose to play in one OR both divisions. Neither division will be flighted.
  - The 1<sup>st</sup> Place Finisher in EACH Division in the Race to the 2022 Cup will receive a **Revolving Trophy** along with the 1<sup>st</sup> place cash payout.
  - All the winners, trophy and cash payouts will be announced at the Holiday Party in December.
- Champions and purse winners of each division at the end of the season will be determined by points accumulated throughout eligible stroke-play events.
- Season will run from Jan 23, 2022 (the Crossings) to November 30, 2022.
- Eligible Player's Cup Events:
  - **Stroke-play events only** (no match-play, scrambles, or other odd formats)
  - Any short or long course with a course and slope rating (able to be posted to GHIN)
  - Weekend OR Weekday events in which there are the minimum of Players Cup participants:
    - 12 for the Net Division
    - 8 for the Gross Division (TBD, depending on the final number of total Division Registrants).
  - **NOTE:** Weekday – Even though we have approximately 1 Weekday event per month, and they are eligible, there still needs to be at least 12 NET Players Cup Participants registered for it to be eligible for earning points and 8 GROSS Players Cup Participants to be eligible. As an example, there were only 3 Weekday events last year that would have qualified for NET based on the criteria of 12 minimum, and two of those events were at Maderas. (Gross Division is new this year). So when you register, you will not know whether the event will be eligible or not. Once registration is full, eligibility for both divisions can be determined.
- Buy-in is \$20 for each Division. The deadline to register is March 7, 2022.
- We are targeting 20 or more registrants for each Division.

**Points System:**

- All Players Cup players will be ranked by total **NET** and **GROSS** scores over the 18 holes for each event.
- The top 12 golfers earn points in descending order in the following point allocation:
  - 1st – 25 pts
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> – 18 pts
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> – 12 pts
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – 9 pts
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – 8 pts, etcTotal points awarded will be 100 points per eligible Event:
  - Ties will split points evenly across the number of tied positions.
  - Positions lower than 12<sup>th</sup> place earn no points that day unless there were ties.

3. The best **8 rounds** for the season for each person (i.e., up to 8 of your best rounds played, with the most points) go into your final total. **For Example:**

*In this example, Louise beats Karen by 6 pts. NA denotes player did not play in the event. Karen failed to place in the top 10 in 1 event, and Louise did not place in the top 10 in 3 events.*

#### Scoring and Play:

- This year, **EVERY** hole needs to be holed out until a Max score of 10 is reached. We will **NOT** be using Net Double Bogey this year.
- If you X-out on any hole during an eligible round, you are disqualified from earning points that round.
- In the NET division, 100% of your Course Handicap will be used in all events.
- All participants must play from the same tee box for the GROSS division events.
- Cup Standings for each Division will be available for viewing after EACH event on our chapter website and possibly Golf Genius.**

#### Payout Distribution:

- \$20 buy-in. The deadline to register is March 7, 2022. You cannot accumulate points until you buy-in (i.e., no back calculation for prior events you played).
- Any year-end standing ties will be broken by the Number of Events played during the season, with the winner of ties being the player who played MORE, not less, events.
- A player must play in at least five rounds to win any purse prize.
- The actual number of entries will determine the prize pool for each division. At least 25% of the players in each division will be awarded cash prizes.
- The 2021 Actual Payout is displayed below. The 2022 Payout most likely will follow a similar format, with the top-3 getting approximately 30%, 15%, and 12%.
