After canceling last year's festival, Artsfest 2021 is set to be held October 16 and a host of new virtual and in-person programs and partnerships are being planned to continue the Arts Alliance's mission to stimulate and promote the creative spirit of Charles County.

After a successful virtual program in the spring, the Southern Maryland Banjo Project returns with inperson Banjo Jam sessions held throughout the county. Banjo Jams are a public jam session featuring a guest facilitator from the community. Participation is free and open to all. Not a musician? Spectators are also welcome to stop by and listen to the tunes. The facilitator leading the jam session will also educate participants and spectators regarding topics as outlined in the Southern Maryland Banjo Projects' Statement of Purpose listed below.

A "soft-opening" of the first jam was held Saturday, August 21, 2021, at the La Plata Farmers Market. Nine musicians participated and over 80 adults and children were engaged. 
