Artwork **should not exceed 2.25" x 6"** (Horizontal or Vertical Layouts accepted) and must be a newly-created, original artwork.

Entries may be submitted to any of the five CCPL branches by **July 12th at 8 PM**. Paper entries can use crayons, regular/colored pencils, markers, pen, paint, and photography/computer generated art.
