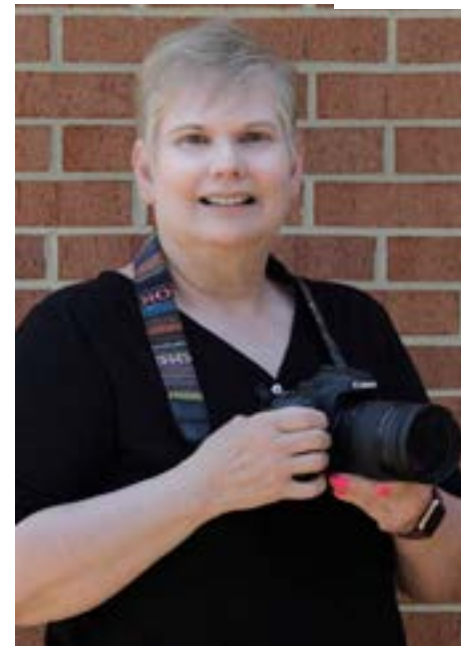

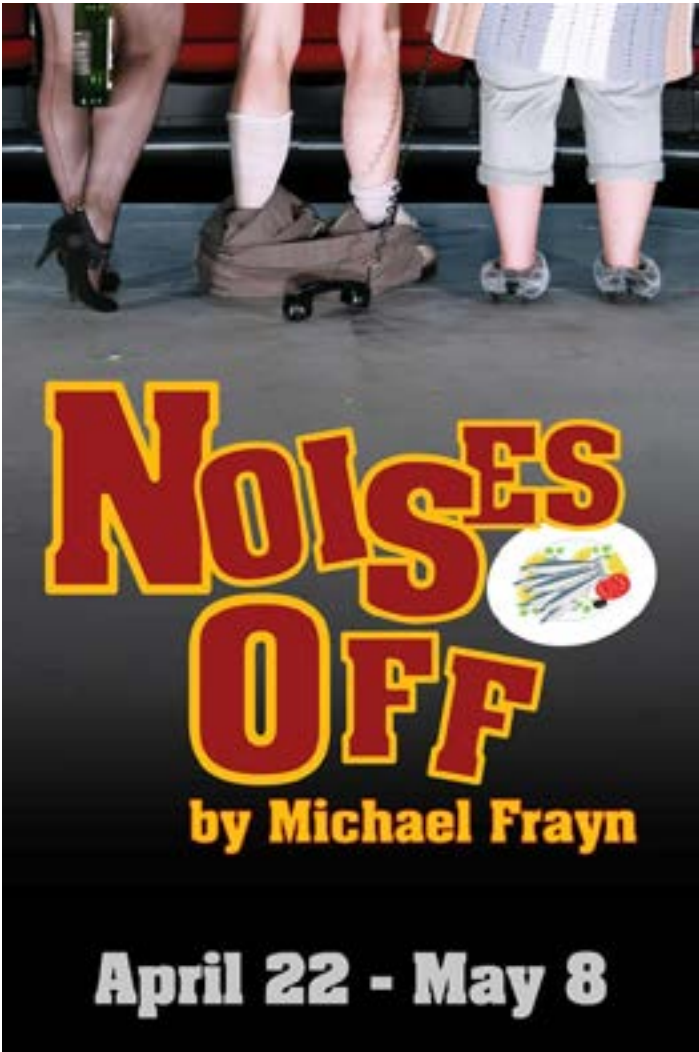
Did you ever want to write a play? If so, consider entering our contest!
