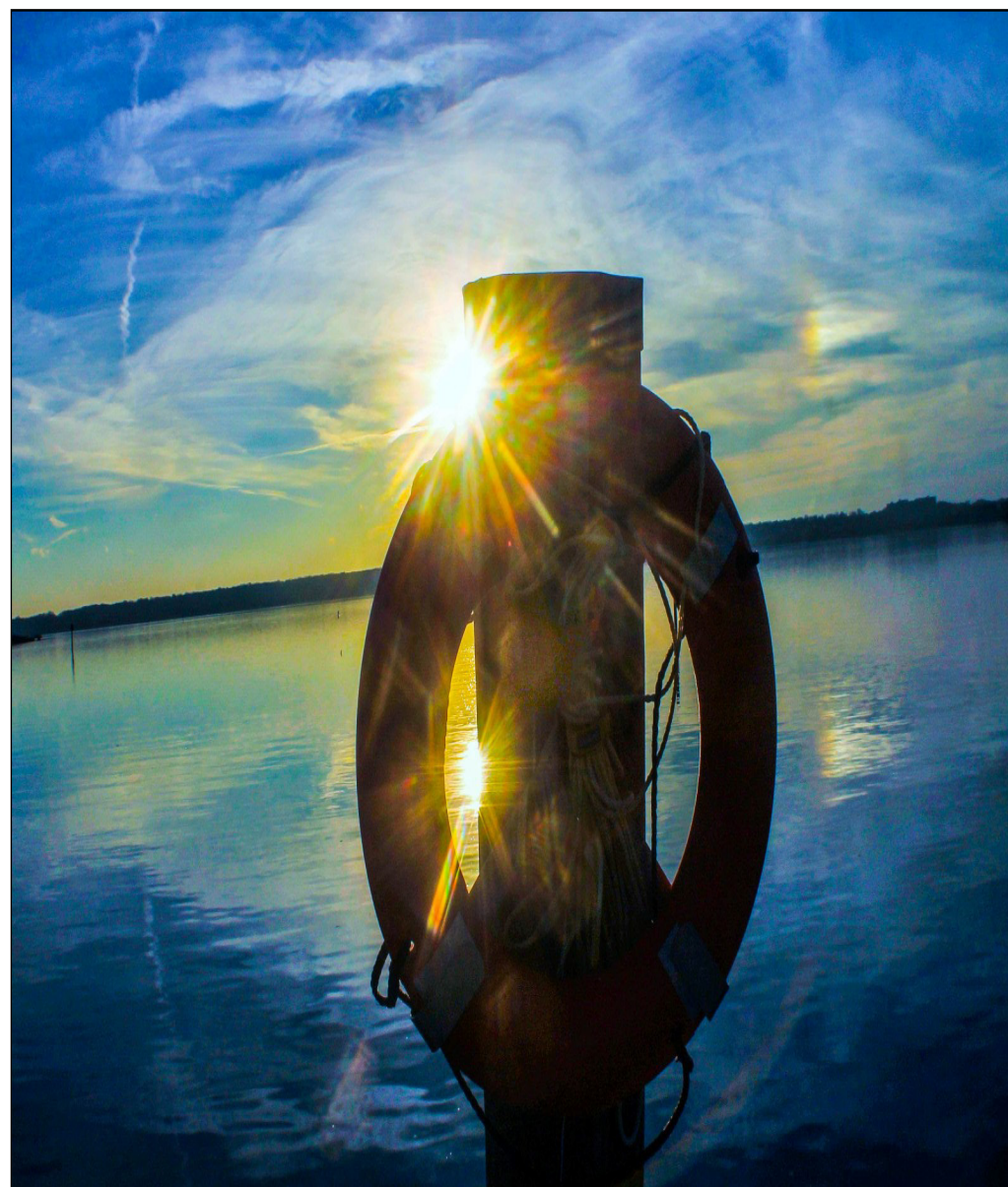

The Community Arts Development Grant Season Returns!



Deadline to Apply is October 15, 2021

The CCAA's Community Arts Development Grant Season returns to its normal cycle for the 2022 fiscal year. The CAD grant program is the CCAA's most well known program and since 1987 a little over \$900,000 in grant funding has been awarded to nonprofit organizations and schools in Charles County. These awards have supported activities in the performing, visual, and literary arts and greatly contributed to the Charles County artistic landscape.

Grants offered this year are: Community Arts Development (CAD) grants for nonprofit organizations, General Operating and Special Project, and Arts in Education (AIE) grants for Charles County private schools.

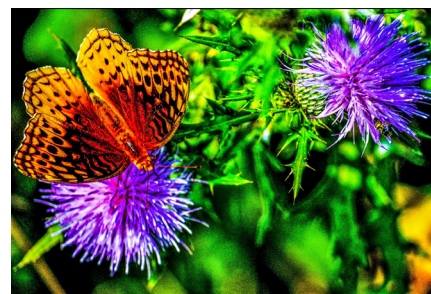
CAD Applications can be downloaded at www.charlescountyarts.org beginning **Monday, August 16, 2021**. AIE applications are being revised and will be available next month.

The CCAA Opened New Art Show in July

The Charles County Commissioners Gallery's newest show includes 20 works by Addison Likins on display through October 5, 2021.

Addison Likins is a James Madison University graduate who studied photography and film making at the University of Virginia graduate school. He has worked as an editor and reporter at the Harrisonburg, VA Daily News-Record, taught English and Journalism at Orange County, VA High School, and worked as an art and technical designer and later as an analyst and manager for Prince George's County Schools in Maryland. He retired from the Maryland school district in 2011 and since then has pursued his artistic passions. He currently exhibits in the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia. His work has been published in regional magazines and selected for and exhibited at several juried and solo show throughout the area. Three of his photographs have been selected by National Geographic Editors during the past two years.

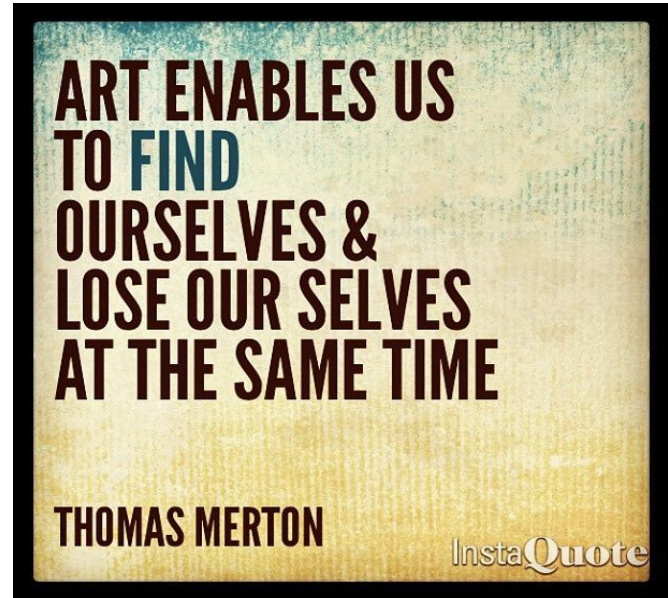
