A Rare Opportunity: Renowned Sr. Lucy Kurien Visits the Pacific Northwest

Sr. Lucy Kurien — the internationally renowned founder of Maher (“Mother’s Home”), whose motto is “love is my religion” and whose rule is that there is always room for more — is bringing her story to the Pacific Northwest this September. In the three decades since its founding, Maher now has 73 homes across 7 states in India, where tens of thousands of destitute and abandoned women, children, and elders have been sheltered in family-style homes built on one simple idea: everyone deserves unconditional love, not just care.
