City Selection Appointment May 2024 Opportunity Notice:

Orange County Transportation Authority Board of Directors

Position:

- **(1) Mayor/Council Member** to serve as the **3rd Supervisorial District Board Member** on the Orange County Transportation Authority's Board of Directors, to be appointed on a **one city/one vote** basis. The candidate must obtain votes comprising a majority of the cities within the Third Supervisorial District. Those cities are Irvine, Lake Forest, Mission Viejo, Rancho Santa Margarita, Villa Park and Yorba Linda. This appointment is for a two-year term that began January 1, 2024 and expires December 31, 2025. This seat is currently held vacant.

Objective: To provide regional transportation planning and public transit in Orange County.

Membership: The Orange County Transportation Authority's Board of Directors consists of 18 members; 10 of these 18 members are appointed by the Orange County City Selection Committee. 5 of these members are from each of the 5 supervisorial districts and appointed on a population weighed vote. The other 5 members are also from each of the 5 supervisorial districts but are appointed on a One City/One vote basis.

Eligibility: Must be a Mayor or City Council Member within each specified County Supervisorial District.

Responsibilities: Coordination of the operation of the public multi-modal transportation services within the county, including provisions of transit services; approval of plans for public mass transit (bus and rail) systems; carrying out capital and service planning which is directed towards the development and approval of a short and long range transportation improvement program with an annual update element reflecting all transportation capital and service priorities. Administration of the County's voter approved half-cent sales tax for transportation to capital project delivery related to freeway improvements, local street and road improvements, rail and transit service that creates

an integrated and balanced transportation system that supports the diverse travel needs and reflects the character of Orange County.

Term: These appointments are for a term of 2 years

Time Commitment: 10-12 hours per month

Meeting Time: Twice a month on 2nd and 4th Mondays at 9:00 a.m.

Meeting Location: OCTA offices, 550 S. Main Street, Orange, CA 92863

Compensation: \$100 per diem, with a maximum of \$500 per month. Compensation includes mileage.

Application Procedure: Candidates who wish to be placed on the ballot must turn in a completed Candidate Statement form to the Orange County Clerk of the Board's office by **April 25, 2024**. Additional candidates nominated by the floor the day of the meeting will be treated as "write-in" candidates on the ballot.

Additionally, the candidate may wish to address a letter to the Mayor of each Orange County city within the supervisorial district announcing their candidacy and outlining their qualifications. The candidate's Mayor may wish to send an endorsement letter to other Orange County Mayors.
