The Board of Trustees

In general, the Board has responsibility for all property of the church, including maintenance and upkeep of the building and grounds, finances and decisions regarding staffing and salaries. At present, we are focused on addressing the financial issues (transition plan) and developing strategies to ensure the long term sustainability of our church.

For the coming year, the Board will have 2 openings, each a 3 year term.

Finance and Investment Committee

There are several openings on this committee, with terms being flexible.

Major changes to our systems (investments, accounting and audit compliance) this past year will require focus by Finance to ensure the changes are meeting the objectives we want. Help from Finance will also be critical for planning and implementation of the transition plan. After a very busy and successful year, there is still important work ahead for this team.

Properties Committee

This team also has several openings, again with flexible terms.

A common thread from our recent survey was: “the building is boring”, “it’s like walking into the Dentists office”, “we need some pizzazz”, “broken stuff needs to be repaired”, “why can’t the windows be cleaned?” The Properties budget for the upcoming fiscal year hopes to address many of these issues, as well as repairs to outdated and broken systems.
