

Our Church Community Is Showing Up To Support My Brother's Table!

Over the past few months individual members contributed 35 gift cards, 500 personalized holiday cards and more than 600 lunch/dinner bags.

Through our Grants Fund, UUCGL donated 250 Market Basket gift certificates for holiday gifting to MBT guests.

Food insecurity is on the rise due to the economic crisis caused by the pandemic. My Brother's Table is serving more meals than ever with fewer on-site volunteers. All meals are to go, and hours have been extended to accommodate precautions.

MBT's response to these challenges is to create a network of volunteers who work from their homes. These off-site volunteers assemble lunch and dinner bags



to supplement the hot foods that MBT prepares and serves every day.

A network of UUCGL members is doing this work from home! More than 15 of our members work either individually or in teams to put together lunch and dinner bags in 25 bag units and deliver them to MBT.

Lunch bags include two peanut butter and jelly sandwiches, juice box, snack, plastic utensils, and napkin. Dinner bags consist of a juice box, snack, plastic utensils, and napkin. Lunch bags are served to guests with hot soup and dinner bags accompany a hot meal.
