# A GENERATION IN JEOPARDY

Over 60% of Haitians live below the poverty line

Many families survive on less than \$2 a day

Haiti has no free public education system

90% of schools are private, requiring tuition  
most families cannot afford

Children often stay home due to lack of funds,  
supplies, or safe access to school
