



FIREMAN LARRY PUBLIC FIRE EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

Nomination Guidelines

The Award is to be presented to an individual or group who has provided outstanding contribution to Public Fire Safety Education in either their community or the State of Michigan.

Criteria: The nominee shall be active in providing fire safety education to individuals of all ages. The nominee does not need to be a member of the local fire department, however, shall work in partnership with the fire service when providing educational offerings. The nominee does not need to be a member of the Michigan Fire Inspectors Society.

The person nominating the recipient/candidate shall provide the following:

1. A letter of nomination regarding the nominee and why the individual should be considered for the award.
2. The nomination letter should detail what outstanding programs he/she has provided and if available articles from local media should be included.
3. It is also recommended that letters of support be obtained and submitted from local schools or group leaders involved.
4. The nominee shall not have been a previous recipient of the Fireman Larry Award.

The award shall be presented at the MFIS Annual Conference Banquet.
