



## FIRE INSPECTOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

### Nomination Guidelines

The purpose of the Fire Inspector of the Year award is to recognize individuals within the Michigan Fire Inspectors Society who have made outstanding contributions to the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the State of Michigan.

A nominee for Fire Inspector of the Year shall meet the following requirements:

1. Shall be an active member of the Michigan Fire Inspectors Society, in good standing.
2. May be nominated either by a member or a non-member of the Michigan Fire Inspectors Society. The nomination shall be in the form of a written application as provided by the Secretary/treasurer. The application shall be submitted **no later than August 15.**
3. Shall have shown outstanding contributions to the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the State of Michigan.
4. Superior performance of normal job duties will not alone justify this award. An individual must have offered exceptionally outstanding contributions over an extended period of time.
5. Shall have made significant contributions towards furthering the goals of the Michigan Fire Inspectors Society.
6. Shall not have been a previous recipient of the Fire Inspector of the Year Award.
7. If awarded, the Fire Inspector of the Year award shall be presented at the annual Education Seminar. The award need not be presented if the committee so votes.
